Leilani Estate "Leash Law"

It has come to the attention of the Leilani Board that you may be in violation of a Leilani Estates, Section II, resolution.

Resolution 10-11-07 states, and I quote, "No dog/dogs shall be allowed to wander on any road or community property in Leilani Estates. It is further resolved that no dog/dogs shall be walked or exercised without a leash on any road or community property, in common, within Leilani Community Association".

The reason the Board of Directors passed this resolution is to respond to the continuous complaints of Leilani residents either walking their dog/dogs off the leash or dog/dogs loose on their property, and their dog/dogs wandering off the property and onto the subdivision roads.

Many residents in our community walk for exercise in the morning. There have been many complaints that dog/dogs have either attacked or threatened them during their walks. All residents have the right to walk on our roads without the threat of a dog/dogs.

We; as a Board, have a responsibility to the community to make it as safe as possible for all residents. This letter is to inform you that if there are any more complaints about your dog/dogs we will be adding a \$50.00 fine to your association assessment for each substantiated complaint that we receive.

The Board hopes that we will no longer have complaints about your dog/dogs. The Board's function is to maintain community property and not to be the police for the community.
