We have been getting reports of nightly disturbances in the way of startled dogs and lanai furniture being re-arranged which we suspect are kids just being mischievous, so please keep your eyes open, talk to your kids, and warn anyone suspicious before someone gets seriously injured.

The Leilani emergency response team (CERT) hosted a disaster preparedness field day March 13 to give our residents information on local evacuation shelters and home emergency kits, and to give everyone an opportunity to ask questions as to emergency response from our Leilani CERT and county and state agencies. Our community attendance was just miserable, so we will offer this again next March and hopefully we won't have a flow, fire, hurricane or huge wind storm between now and then...
