Hi Neighbor,

Everything continues to be quiet for our Watch Patrols with the crime stats for April showing a single burglary last month on Leilani avenue of an unlocked home that resulted in a stolen stove and refrigerator. This compares to **(196)** crimes across all of Puna during the month of April, so thanks again to our volunteer patrols !

We continue to respond to dog issues due to the fact that many of our residents refuse to chain or fence their animals. We have had to ask the Humane Society for help recently with several dogs that are constantly loose in front of 1132 Kahukai, with a very aggressive Rottweiler at 753 Malama, and with a vicious Pit Bull out front of 1128 Malama. If you have problems with any loose dogs please call the **Humane Society at 966-5458** with a description and location of the animal and ask that they pick up the dog immediately.

With summer vacations starting real soon we will have the local police and their radar speed board on Leilani avenue during the first week of June to try to slow down the speeding motorists. We will need everyone's help that day to wave signs and generally harass the drivers, so we'll confirm the exact date at our meeting 5/25.
